

College Credit Classes in the High School

Mesa State College offers some college credit classes in area high schools. Students who are interested in this option should contact their high school counselor to determine if any courses are being offered at their high school. Eligibility Policies & Procedures

High school students with either junior or senior standing may be allowed to register for college classes that are not replicated through the school district curriculum under the guidelines of HB 1244. In some cases, the school district or the Colorado Department of Education will pay the tuition of the student to attend Mesa State College (summer school excluded). Students are always responsible for payment of any and all fees, books and supplies. The student is responsible for payment of tuition not covered by the school district or the Colorado Department of Education. Students should understand that being a concurrently enrolled student does not guarantee acceptance to Mesa State College, nor does Mesa State College guarantee that the approved classes will be available upon registration.
