

AMBASSADOR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Colorado Mesa University Ambassador Program is designed to attract top student leaders, providing students the opportunity to further develop leadership skills through a variety of activities involving recruitment, campus outreach and much more. The Ambassador Program requires a significant amount of time (15-25+ hours per week) as the Ambassadors are involved in many aspects of admission and recruitment activities.

Ambassador Program Participants will

- Assist the Admissions Office with recruitment and campus tours.
- Develop leadership qualities through fundraising, community service projects and event coordination.
- Recognize that being an Ambassador is a unique and highly visible position. An Ambassador's actions should always be representative of the University and portray the program in a positive light.
- Maintain a minimum 3.0 institutional GPA

Application Deadline:

January 15

Award Amount:

- Full Tuition and Student Fees
- Up to 120 credit hours; renewable based on performance

Application Procedures:

To be considered for the Ambassador Scholarship, students must be incoming first-time freshmen and have a cumulative high school grade point average of 3.25 or above*. Students must demonstrate significant contributions to their school and community.

Application Packets Must Include:

- The completed application.
- A resume of all leadership positions and activities in high school and in the community, including any special honors or awards.
- Two letters of recommendation.
- An essay (no more than two pages) describing why you want to be a Colorado Mesa University Ambassador and outlining how you can contribute to the Ambassador program.
- An official or unofficial high school transcript for GPA verification.
- ACT or SAT test scores.
