PLUMLEIGH PHOTOJOURNALISM SCHOLARSHIP**

Mesa State College Foundation is deeply honored to have the privilege of awarding the Plumleigh Photojournalism Scholarship. This scholarship fund is endowed in memory of Charlotte and Glen Plumleigh, Mesa State Alumni, whose lives were claimed in the September 2, 1998, Swissair III airline crash in Nova Scotia, Canada. Established by the couple's children, Deborah L. Diasparra and Lieutenant Commander Martin L. Plumleigh, they wish to honor their parents by offering students majoring in photojournalism and/or videography the chance to further their education toward obtaining a job in this field.

Glen Plumleigh began his career at KREX-TV in Grand Junction before moving to Denver to work for Channel 2 News, Adolph Coors Company, and eventually owning his own business, Video Productions, Inc. Glen shot video, edited and produced the Coors Brewery's monthly video magazine, title "Second Century," which was distributed to all Coors distributors. He recently produced two award-winning videos, "The Fire Burning" and "A Life and Death Decision."

The Plumleigh Photojournalism Scholarship is awarded annually to a recipient chose by a Mesa State College selection committee.

Scholarship Criteria/Information

1. Students shall attend Mesa State College full time (12 or more credits each semester).
2. Must have achieved and maintain at least a cumulative GPA of 3.3.
3. Must be classified as a sophomore or above.
4. Shall be enrolled in the School of Humanities and Social Sciences, majoring in Mass Communications with a declared concentration in broadcast journalism.
5. The deadline to apply for this scholarship is **March 1, 2010**.
6. The winner will be announced during the awards ceremony at the Annual Mesa State College Media Day.
7. The amount of the scholarship shall be based on funds available.
