

THE WESTERN SLOPE VIETNAM WAR MEMORIAL PARK SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Scholarship(s) in the amount of \$1,500 are available to continuing Colorado Mesa University and WCCC students for the upcoming academic year.

Deadline to apply: March 1

GENERAL GUIDELINES:

1. **MILITARY SERVICE** – Applicants must be either on active duty, an honorably discharged Military Service member, or the child or grandchild of an active duty or honorably discharged Military Service member.
2. **AREAS OF STUDY** – Applicants may be enrolled in any area of study, pursuing an Associate or Baccalaureate Degree. Applicants must not have a prior Baccalaureate Degree. Applicants must have completed at least their first year of studies.
3. **GRADE POINT AVERAGE** – Applicants must have and maintain a minimum GPA of 3.0.
4. **HOURS OF ENROLLMENT** – Recipients must enroll in and complete a minimum of 12 credit hours each semester at Mesa State College or UTEC.
5. **ACTIVITIES** – Recipient is expected to have a record of civic and/or school activities.
6. **NEED** – Recipient must demonstrate financial need.
7. **SELECTION PROCESS** – All qualified applicants' applications will be submitted to the Western Slope Vietnam War Memorial Park, Inc. for their review and selection of the recipients.

8. DISBURSEMENT – Scholarships will be disbursed to the recipients in the amount of \$750 for the fall semester and \$750 for the spring semester.
9. APPLICATION PROCEDURES – Complete the application on the next page. It is NOT necessary to include a transcript of your grades with this application. The deadline to apply and submit the completed application to the Financial Aid Office is March 1.
10. If a recipient is selected for and accepts another award, which combined with this award exceeds the amount of tuition and fees, this scholarship will become null and void.
