Required Attachments:

1. A list and brief description of the public service activities and organizations in which you have been involved. Include leadership positions.
2. A transcript of credits completed to date.
3. A statement listing courses in which you are currently enrolled.
4. A brief biographical essay (one or two pages) which includes a statement of your educational goals and plans for a career in science. Describe your leadership style and the leadership qualities you feel are important for a career in science. The essay will be used as a sample of your writing ability.
5. Three letters of recommendation from college faculty or other individuals who can address your academic work, personal qualities, leadership ability, and potential for a career in science. At least one letter must be from a faculty member teaching in your academic major area and from whom you have taken a course.

NOTE: Scholarship awards are based on a full academic year and are disbursed by semester. Receipt of a scholarship may affect your eligibility for financial aid through Mesa State College. Please check with the Office of Financial Aid.
