PROVIDING TAX INFORMATION

Please read carefully!

You have been selected by the U.S. Department of Education for a process called verification which requires the Financial Aid Office to verify the information provided on your FAFSA.

To submit student, parent or spouse tax information for your verification, you must choose one of the options below.

Option 1: Link your FAFSA to your Tax Information

This option is not currently available from the IRS as they are updating security features of the application. We are anticipating that this will be available after October 1, 2017. Please use one of the other options below to provide tax information needed for financial aid verifications.

Option 2: Submit a <u>signed</u> copy of your federal tax return

Submit a <u>signed</u> copy of your 1040 federal tax return for 2015. If it is a 1040 or 1040A, we just need the first two pages. If it is a 1040EZ, we just need the one page.

Option 3: Submit an IRS Tax Return Transcript

Submit an IRS Tax Return Transcript for 2015 which you can obtain from the IRS website https://www.irs.gov/transcript
