ANNOUNCEMENT OF POSITION VACANCY
Assistant Professor of Mathematics
(revised announcement)

RESPONSIBILITIES: The primary responsibility of this position is teaching a combination of lower division and upper division mathematics courses in the department of Computer Science, Mathematics and Statistics. The standard teaching load is 12 credit hours per semester. The successful candidate is expected to maintain a program of scholarship, to advise students, and to perform campus and professional service in line with our mission of fostering a student-centered learning environment.

EDUCATION & EXPERIENCE: A Ph.D. in mathematics from a regionally accredited institution is required, and must be completed by August 2010. Good communication skills are required. Preference will be given to candidates with records of outstanding teaching at the college level, including a demonstrated ability to provide high quality teaching in upper and lower division courses; a dedication to scholarship, including undergraduate research; and a commitment to campus and professional service. Some consideration will be given for coursework or teaching experience in Mathematics Education.

TYPE OF APPOINTMENT: Full-time tenure track appointment to begin in August 2010.

SALARY: Commensurate with education and experience. Excellent health and benefits package.
