Assistant Professor of Education/Exceptional Learner

**RESPONSIBILITIES:** Teach general and special education courses at both the graduate and undergraduate levels. Supervise Master's internship experiences in a P-12 environment. Develop, implement and coordinate Master's Program for the Exceptional Learner: Special Education and Gifted & Talented. Collaborate with Graduate admissions to support marketing of the program. Engage in scholarly activity, provide service to the department, college, community and profession, and participate in advising duties for the department and college. Teaching off-campus may be necessary, which will require travel to regional sites or online delivery.

**EDUCATION & EXPERIENCE:** Doctorate in Education with an emphasis in special education or closely related field from an accredited institution required. ABD with proof of completion date no later than December 2010 may be considered. Requirements also include experience with Gifted and Talented education and a minimum of three years in a K-12 setting (special education preferred). Preference given to candidates with experience using technology to enhance teaching and demonstrated experience coordinating programs or grants.

**TYPE OF APPOINTMENT:** Full-time (August – May) tenure-track appointment beginning August 2010. Additional summer teaching required.

**SALARY:** Commensurate with education, experience, and qualifications.
