Assistant Professor of Business- Economics/Quantitative Decision Making

**RESPONSIBILITIES:** In the area of economics, teaching will be required at both the undergraduate and graduate levels in at least two of the following areas: Principles, Intermediate Microeconomics, Intermediate Macroeconomics, Labor/Management Relations, Public Sector, International Economics, Managerial Economics and Quantitative Decision Making as well as other related business areas. The successful candidate must contribute to the overall strength of the economics concentration, quantitative decision making and the business department. Involvement with professional organizations, scholarship in discipline and service to the academic community is expected.

**EDUCATION & EXPERIENCE:** Masters degree in Business or Economics, from an accredited institution required; PhD preferred. Preference given to college-level teaching experience, significant practical work experience in discipline and publication record, as well as the ability to teach in the area of quantitative decision making and a working knowledge of Excel. Because teaching is a priority at Mesa State College, all applicants must submit evidence of teaching excellence, including student evaluations if available in order to be considered. An interest in regional economics is preferred, along with econometric and quantitative decision making skills.

**TYPE OF APPOINTMENT:** Full-time, tenure-track appointment.
