



ANNOUNCEMENT OF POSITION VACANCY
Assistant Professor of Statistics

SUMMARY/RESPONSIBILITIES: Colorado Mesa University's Department of Computer Science, Mathematics, and Statistics invites applications for a tenure-track Assistant Professor of Statistics. The primary responsibility of this position is to teach a combination of lower division and upper division statistics courses. The standard teaching load is 12 credit hours per semester; teaching may involve online, hybrid and/or distance delivery modalities. The successful candidate is expected to maintain a program of scholarship, to advise students, and to perform campus and professional service in line with our mission of fostering a student-centered learning environment.

REQUIRED EDUCATION & EXPERIENCE:

A Ph.D. in Statistics or Mathematics from a regionally accredited institution is required and must be completed by August 2017. If the Ph.D. is in Mathematics, the candidate must have earned at least 18 graduate credit hours in statistics or have five years of industry experience in statistics. Excellent communication skills are required.

DESIRED QUALIFICATIONS/EXPERIENCE: Preference will be given to candidates with a record of outstanding teaching at the college level, including a demonstrated ability to provide high quality teaching in upper and lower division courses; a dedication to scholarship, including undergraduate research; work experience in statistics; and a commitment to campus and professional service.

Colorado Mesa University is particularly interested in candidates who have experience working with students from diverse backgrounds and who have a demonstrated commitment to improving the levels of access and success for underrepresented students within higher education.

TYPE OF APPOINTMENT: Full-time tenure-track position to begin August 2017.
