



ANNOUNCEMENT OF POSITION VACANCY
Chemistry Instructor

RESPONSIBILITIES: Full-time position (non –tenure track) responsible for teaching lower division lecture and laboratory courses in chemistry. Qualified candidates may also have the opportunity to teach organic chemistry laboratory courses. The standard teaching load is 12 credit hours per semester with the possibility of teaching up to 15 credit hours with additional compensation. Teaching may involve online, hybrid and/or distance delivery modalities. Colorado Mesa University is particularly interested in candidates who have experience working with students from diverse backgrounds and a demonstrated commitment to improving the levels of access and success for underrepresented students within higher education.

EDUCATION & EXPERIENCE: A masters or doctorate degree in chemistry or a related discipline from an accredited institution by the summer of 2017 is required. Must demonstrate enthusiasm for consistently teaching lower division chemistry courses for science and liberal arts majors. Interest in working with undergraduates and effective communication skills are required.

TYPE OF APPOINTMENT: Full-time instructor position, beginning August 2017.

SALARY: Commensurate with education and experience. Excellent health and retirement benefits package.
