Instructor of Speech

RESPONSIBILITIES: Teach a standard course load of 12 hours per semester in speech including Speechmaking, Interpersonal Communication, Persuasion, and Essential Speech (a one-credit co-requisite to CMU's interdisciplinary general education capstone). Collaboration with departmental faculty in the development and refinement of program curriculum required.

EDUCATION & EXPERIENCE: Minimum of an M.A. in Speech, Communications or related discipline required. PhD. or ABD preferred. Degree must be from an accredited institution.

DESIRED QUALIFICATIONS/EXPERIENCE: Evidence of successful prior college level teaching desirable. Colorado Mesa University is particularly interested in candidates who have experience working with students from diverse backgrounds and who have a demonstrated commitment to improving the levels of access and success for underrepresented students within higher education.

TYPE OF APPOINTMENT: Full-time instructor appointment to begin Fall, 2016.
