ANNOUNCEMENT OF POSITION VACANCIES
Instructor of Mathematics/Statistics (Four Positions)

RESPONSIBILITIES:

Positions I-III: Teaching responsibilities will consist of lower-level undergraduate mathematics and/or statistics courses such as College Math, College Algebra, PreCalculus, Probability and Statistics, Statistics for Social and Behavioral Sciences and Introduction to Business Analysis. These positions are on our main campus in Grand Junction, CO.

Position IV: This position resides with our satellite campus in Montrose, CO. Teaching responsibilities will consist of developmental and lower-level undergraduate mathematics courses, specifically Foundations of Math, College Math, College Algebra, and Probability and Statistics.

The standard teaching load is 12 credit hours per semester for all four positions. Teaching may involve online, hybrid and/or distance delivery modalities. A successful candidate will be expected to serve in line with our mission of fostering a student-centered learning environment.

REQUIRED EDUCATION & EXPERIENCE: Master's degree from an accredited institution in Mathematics, Statistics or closely related field. Other requirements include demonstrated high-quality teaching and good communication skills.

Colorado Mesa University is particularly interested in candidates who have experience working with students from diverse backgrounds and who have a demonstrated commitment to improving the levels of access and success for underrepresented students within higher education.

TYPE OF APPOINTMENT: Each position is full-time, renewable, non-tenure track, to begin in August 2017.

SALARY: Commensurate with education and experience. Excellent health and retirement benefits package.
