



Colorado Mesa University - Montrose Campus seeks two part-time lecturers for our new Certified Nursing Assistant program available to Montrose and Olathe High School students.

Part-Time Lecturer

Instruction responsibilities include:

- training students through lecture, laboratory demonstration, laboratory practice, and clinical experience
- coordinating the activities of clinical and lab instructors supporting the program
- utilizing the textbooks, curriculum and syllabus already selected and approved
- reviewing lesson plans and preparing for class instruction
- maintaining student attendance records and tracking clinical hours
- evaluating performance of students and recording completion of assignments and grades
- class time is 7:30 a.m. - 9:20 a.m. in the upcoming fall and spring semesters

Required:

- an RN with current unencumbered Colorado professional nursing license
- at least two years of nursing experience in caring for the elderly and/or the chronically ill of any age of which at least one year must be in the provision of services in a long-term care facility.
- at least one year experience in managing nursing aides, OR have completed a course in teaching adults (e.g., Train the Trainer), OR have documented experience in teaching adults

Part-Time Clinical and Lab Lecturer

Instruction responsibilities include:

- assisting with lab exercise instruction and clinical site instruction
- providing supervision at various clinical sites in Montrose and Delta
- clinical dates are flexible
- lab instruction is 7:30 a.m. - 9:20 a.m. in the upcoming spring semester, commencing January, 2018

Required:

- an active unencumbered RN or LPN
- at least one year of nursing experience in caring for the elderly and/or the chronically ill of any age
- at least one year of experience in managing nursing aides or completed a course in teaching adults (e.g., Train the Trainer) or documented experience in teaching adults

No teaching licensure is required to instruct either of these programs. CMU will provide instructors training on the course curriculum and teaching standards.
