



ANNOUNCEMENT OF POSITION VACANCY
Program Director / Assistant Professor of Social Work

SUMMARY: Colorado Mesa University invites applications for a Program Director / Assistant Professor of Social Work position. This position provides leadership to the BSW program including the overall direction and management of the BSW program, administration, and oversight of the CSWE accreditation process. As a faculty member in the department, this position is also responsible for student advising, scholarship, and teaching. The standard teaching load for this position is nine credit hours per semester, and may include Research Methods, Social Welfare Policy, Intervention Methods/Practice Classes: Micro, Mezzo, and Macro, and Introduction to Social Work. Teaching may involve online, hybrid and/or distance delivery modalities.

REQUIRED EDUCATION & EXPERIENCE:

- a Masters of Social Work from a Council on Social Work Education (CSWE) - accredited program
- two years post-MSW practice experience
- college teaching experience
- demonstrated commitment to excellence in teaching, scholarship, service, and advising students
- advanced interpersonal and leadership skills, and the ability to work effectively as a team member

PREFERRED EDUCATION/EXPERIENCE:

- a Doctorate of Social Work or PhD/ABD
- five years' practice experience and/or present as a Licensed Clinical Social Worker
- CSWE accreditation experience
- experience as a program director of a CSWE accredited program
- Colorado Mesa University is particularly interested in candidates who have experience working with students from diverse backgrounds and who have a demonstrated commitment to improving the levels of access and success for underrepresented students within higher education.

TYPE OF APPOINTMENT: Full-time nine month tenure-track appointment, to begin August 2017.
