Visiting Assistant Professor – Applied Violin & Viola/Chamber Music

RESPONSIBILITIES: The Department of Music at Colorado Mesa University seeks a dynamic violin performer - teacher. Responsibilities for this position are to teach applied violin and viola, coach chamber music, teach string pedagogy and materials (upper strings), recruit for the violin/viola studio and perform in the CMU Piano Trio. Teaching may involve online, hybrid, and/or distance delivery modalities. The successful candidate also has the opportunity to serve as the Concertmaster of the Grand Junction Symphony Orchestra, under a separate contract, contingent upon a successful audition.

REQUIRED EDUCATION & EXPERIENCE: Master's degree from an accredited institution and exceptional performance experience both as a soloist and chamber musician.

DESIRED QUALIFICATIONS/EXPERIENCE: Doctorate degree from an accredited institution, college/public school teaching experience, ability to conduct an orchestra, teach academic courses in one of the following areas: orchestration, music theory, music history or music education. In addition to classical music, abilities with eclectic styles, improvisation, composition, or entrepreneurial activities as a performing musician are desirable.

Colorado Mesa University is particularly interested in candidates who have experience working with students from diverse backgrounds and who have demonstrated commitment to improving the levels of access and success for underrepresented students within higher education.

TYPE OF APPOINTMENT: One-year Visiting Assistant Professor appointment beginning August 14, 2017.
