



**Visiting Assistant Professor of Physics
2017-2018**

SUMMARY: Colorado Mesa University's Physics Program invites applications for a one-year, full-time Visiting Assistant Professor of Physics for the 2017-18 academic year. Responsibilities include teaching a 12 credit hour course load per semester in introductory courses and laboratories and upper-division courses. Teaching may involve online, hybrid, and/or distance delivery modalities.

REQUIRED:

- Ph.D. from an accredited institution in Physics or a closely related discipline by August 14, 2017
- Strong interest in teaching undergraduate physics
- Strong communication skills.
- Students with all but dissertation status will be considered at the instructor rank.
- Applicants from all areas of physics are encouraged to apply.

Colorado Mesa University is particularly interested in candidates who have experience working with students from diverse backgrounds and who have a demonstrated commitment to improving the levels of access and success for underrepresented students within higher education.

TYPE OF APPOINTMENT: One year, full-time position, beginning August 2017.
