**Visiting Professor/Instructor of Computer Information Systems**

**SUMMARY/RESPONSIBILITIES:** The Visiting Professor/Instructor of Computer Information Systems in Colorado Mesa University's Department of Business is responsible to teach Business Information Technology (Microsoft Office), Fundamentals of Information Systems, Advanced Business Software, Programming in a Business Environment, and other possible courses dependent upon expertise. The standard teaching load is 12 course credit hours per semester; some assigned courses may be taught online, hybrid, or via distance delivery modalities. The visiting professor/instructor will collaborate with departmental faculty in the development, implementation and assessment of program curriculum and contribute to the overall strength of the business department.

Colorado Mesa University (CMU) is a state-funded institution that emphasizes quality teaching and research. The Business Department at CMU is currently in the process of obtaining AACSB accreditation and our application has been accepted.

**EDUCATION:** Master's degree in Computer Information Systems (CIS), Business, or related area required; PhD or ABD in CIS or Business preferred. Degree must be from an accredited institution.
