Agriculture Finance (AGRS 208)

Qualifications: Master's degree required in agriculture, business or related area. Experience teaching or making group presentations preferred. Classes are on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 8:00 to 9:15 a.m., January 17 - May 11.

Course Description: Emphasizes principles of finance and their applications to agriculture and agribusiness, including the time value of money, net present value analysis, interest, credit lending institutions, financial statements and financial ratios.

Animal Science (AGRS 105)

Qualifications: Master's degree required, preferably in the agricultural sciences area. Experience in the agriculture industry or related fields. Classes are on Fridays from 1:00 to 2:30 p.m., January 17 - May 11.

Course Description: Fundamentals of livestock production. Principles of breeding, genetics, nutrition, health, and physiology of beef, sheep, swine, dairy, and horses. Focus on the Animal Science Industry in general and each species industry in regard to history, current situation, and future.

Livestock Practicum/Lab (AGRS 288 & 288L)

Qualifications: Master's degree required, preferably in the agricultural sciences area. Experience in the livestock management industry. Classes are on Wednesdays from 1:00 to 5:00 p.m. January 17 - May 11.

Course Description: Provides experiential learning with beef cattle, dairy cattle, swine and sheep.
