MSC and WCCC offer first energy camp for seventh graders

Grand Junction – How would you like to design and build a solar-powered car? Youngsters who will enter seventh grade next fall will have that opportunity at the first PROTOCAMP sponsored by the El Pomar Northwest Regional Council, Mesa State College and Western Colorado Community College. The camp will focus on energy, math and science.

The camp will be at the Tilman M. Bishop Campus of Western Colorado Community College, 2508 Blichmann Ave., the week of June 22-26 from 9 am to 3 pm each day. In addition to building a solar-powered car, campers will have the chance to work on other hands-on, creative science projects.
