Instructor of Statistics/Mathematics (Two Positions)

RESPONSIBILITIES

Position I: Teaching responsibilities will consist mostly of undergraduate statistics courses with occasional lower level undergraduate mathematics courses. This position is on our main campus in Grand Junction, CO.

Position II: Teaching responsibilities will consist of lower level undergraduate mathematics and statistics courses. This position is on our satellite campus in Montrose, CO.

The standard teaching load is 12 credit hours per semester. The successful candidate will be expected to serve in line with our mission of fostering a student-centered learning environment.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE

Position I: Master's degree in Statistics is preferred. Master's degree in Mathematics, or some related field, with significant coursework in Statistics will be considered.

Position II: Master's degree in Mathematics or Statistics is preferred. MS in a closely related field with significant coursework in Mathematics/Statistics will be considered.

Other requirements include demonstrated high-quality teaching and good communication skills.

TYPE OF APPOINTMENT

Each position is full-time, renewable, non-tenure track, to begin in August 2012.
