Colorado law requires all males between 17 years and nine months and 26 years of age to certify that they have registered with Selective Service before enrolling in any state-supported institution in Colorado. Colorado Mesa University is required to have on record a statement of your registration status. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.

Information on Selective Service registration status must be provided in order to comply with Colorado law. You may register and/or check your registration status on line at www.sss.gov. Individuals providing false information are subject to penalty of law.

- I certify that I am not required to register with the Selective Service because:
 - (1) I am a female.
 - (2) I am in the armed services on active duty. (Note: This does not apply to members of the Reserves and National Guard who are not on active duty.)
 - (3) I have not reached the age of 17 years and nine months.
 - (4) I am over the age of 26, as of the first day of classes for the semester for which I am registering.
 - (5) I am a veteran of the U. S. Armed Forces. (Note: This does not apply to members of the Reserves and National Guard who are not on active duty.)
 - (6) I am a lawfully admitted non-immigrant alien.

I affirm, under penalty of perjury, that the information presented on this form is true and complete. If asked by an authorized official, I agree to give proof of the information I have provided.
