Option 2	<input type="checkbox"/> A minimum of one semester at Colorado Mesa University and in good academic standing. <input type="checkbox"/> Completion of 30 or more semester credit hours (CMU and transfer work). <input type="checkbox"/> G.P.A. of 2.40 or higher in all coursework. (CMU and transfer work, including all D's and F's).
Option 3	<input type="checkbox"/> Completion of 13 credits at CMU numbered 100-499 with a "D" or better. <input type="checkbox"/> G.P.A. of 2.40 or higher in all CMU coursework. <input type="checkbox"/> HEAR Requirements: Students who graduated high school after 2007 must also meet the Colorado Higher Education Admissions Requirements (HEAR) requirements. Students typically meet this by taking ENGC 090/ENGL 111 or higher, MATC 091/MATH 110 or higher, a Natural Science course, and a History/Social Science course from CMU or other regionally accredited college or university. Majors requiring a foreign language will also require one language course. OR <input type="checkbox"/> Students who graduated high school prior to 2008 must complete the English/Math Criteria only.
Option 4	<input type="checkbox"/> Students with 60 or more credit hours who are in good academic standing (2.0 cumulative GPA or higher) must submit a letter outlining their academic plan to the Enrollment Appeals committee in the Registrar's office along with this form. The committee will evaluate such admissions requests on the basis of a) prior successful performance in academic classes related to a proposed major b) the written explanation of why past poor performance was not typical and c) detailed plans for improvement going forward.

Some baccalaureate programs may require a higher G.P.A. and/or impose additional requirements for admission. Please refer to the specific program sheet and to the current Colorado Mesa University catalog for admission requirements of particular programs. Students are ultimately and solely responsible for knowing and fulfilling the admission and graduation requirements for particular degree programs.
