Transfer Articulation Agreement Between Technical College of the Rockies and Western Colorado Community College

Associate of Applied Science: Applied Technology

Term Agreement: 2023-2026

VP of Academic Affairs

PURPOSE: To provide a pathway to an Associate of applied studies degree for students who have earned a Career and Technical Education (CTE) certificate at the Technical College of the Rockies (TCR) in a subject area for which an associate degree is not offered at WCCC.

TERMS/CONDITIONS: Students requesting credit must have completed a technical certificate from TCR. This does not include certificates obtained using Community Courses.

PROCESS: Students shall be responsible for initiating the process by making an application according to the conditions of the Articulation Agreement Application Process document.

CURRICULUM: Students may transfer up to 43 technical certificate credit hours into the AAS - Applied Technology degree. If the Technical Certificate is less than 43 hours, additional technical coursework (from a single area of study) if electives from WCCC will be needed to bring the total technical hours to 43 hours. Additionally, the completion of 17 hours within Essential Learning (general education) and Lower Division requitements coursework from WCCC/CMU and any other degree requirements will allow the student to earn the Associate of Applied Science in Applied Technology.

REVISIONS: This agreement shall be reviewed at the end of each academic year.

TRANSFER ARTICULATION AGREEMENT APPLICATION PROCESS ELIGIBILITY:

ELIGIBILITY:

- Student must be currently enrolled for credit at Western Colorado Community College or Colorado Mesa University (CMU) at the time of application for credit.
- Student must meet the academic residency requirement of a minimum of 15 of the final 30 credit hours must be taken from CMU/WCCC.
- Student must have successfully completed a Technical Certificate from Technical College of the Rockies in a subject area for which an associate degree is not offered at WCCC

STUDENT APPLICATION PROCESS:

STEP 1: Student must enroll at Western Colorado Community College or Colorado Mesa University (CMU) and complete 17 credit hours within essential learning (general education) and lower division courses. Student may need to contact WCCC Student Services upon enrollment to ensure that college coursework does not duplicate articulated credit.

STEP 2: Student must have TCR send an official transcript directly to WCCC/CMU which indicates the technical certificate has been awarded. The technical certificate must be in a subject area for which an associate degree is not offered at WCCC.

STEP 3: Upon successful completion of 17 credit hours within essential learning and lower division courses at WCCC or CMU, student must contact WCCC Student Services at WCCCStudentServices@coloradomesa.edu and submit documentation identified in step 2.

STEP 4: WCCC Student Services staff will review the documents submitted to determine whether the terms and conditions of the WCCC/TCR transfer articulation agreement have been met. The Registrar's Office will add the Technical Certificate coursework to the student's record.
