- 1) Creation of "marker" courses in every program that will help students more readily identify whether they are on track to graduate.
- 2) Creation of alerts to students and advisors when financial aid limits are being approached more rapidly than progress toward degree.
- 3) Creation of (mandatory?) video resources for students that will assist in the usage of registration processes and DegreeWorks.
- 4) Creation of (mandatory?) faculty training on Advise and DegreeWorks.
