2017 Convocation

Convocation also serves to introduce, acquaint and connect our incoming students with our Mission, Vision and Values, while also reminding and reaffirming these fundamental precepts to and for our faculty, staff and campus community. We celebrate these entrances (convocation) and exits (commencement) as meaningful opportunities to recognize and celebrate the transformative experience that is higher education.
