“Teaching Students on the  
Autism Spectrum in the  
College Classroom”

The purpose of this session is to present information about Autism Spectrum Disorders as a means to help faculty create an atmosphere in their classes that will benefit not only the ASD student, but the class as a whole. Information about changes to the ASD diagnosis will be presented, and will include up-to-date information about the range of educational challenges experienced by those who have ASD (VanBergeijk, Klin & Volkmar, 2008; White, et al., 2016). Classroom management will also be addressed, including what needs to be discussed with the student and the use of non-verbal cues to help the AS student self-manage in the classroom.
