



## 2012-13 Post Baccalaureate Licensure: Secondary

The Colorado Mesa University Post Baccalaureate Licensure program does not grant a degree. It is designed to provide the coursework necessary to obtain Colorado Department of Education licensure. Candidates in this program already hold a bachelor's degree in content areas for which the CMU Center for Teacher Education is approved to grant licensure.

Candidates must complete 42 credit hours of coursework in addition to a minimum of 800 hours of supervised field experience. As shown in the grid below, these hours are earned across three semesters.

Successful applicants to the program must pass the CDE content licensure exam and have a minimum GPA of 2.8. Candidates must maintain a minimum 3.0 GPA to remain and complete the program.

### SUGGESTED COURSE SEQUENCING FOR POST BACCALAUREATE LICENSURE: SECONDARY

This is a recommended sequence of course work. Certain courses may have prerequisites or are only offered during the Fall or Spring semesters. It is the student's responsibility to meet with the assigned advisor and check the 2 year course matrix on the Colorado Mesa website for course availability.
