

Day 18: Did you know that CMU is expected to document how it meets the Higher Learning Commission's Criteria for Accreditation?

Most of CMU's preparation for its comprehensive evaluation has focused on evidence in support of HLC's Criteria for Accreditation. Peer reviewers, serving on behalf of HLC, determine if an institution meets the criteria and its components by facts rather than professional judgment. The broad areas covered by the Criteria:

- A. Integrity: Ethical and Responsible Conduct
- B. Teaching and Learning: Quality, Resources, and Support
- C. Teaching and Learning: Evaluation and Improvement
- D. Resources, Planning, and Institutional Effectiveness
