**Did you know that the Campus Safety Assistant program provides safe pedestrian travel around campus and is a free service available to all CMU students, staff, and faculty everyday between 6 pm and 2 am?**

*Self-Study Report, Evidence Item 3D1-6: CMU provides for the safety and security of its students.*

CMU is committed to the safety and security of all members of its campus community, believing that academic freedom can flourish only in an environment that is free of criminal or other disruptive activity and unsafe conditions. All public safety services on the CMU campus are provided by the Grand Junction Police Department, with officers staffing two locations. They are responsible for maintaining the campus community as a place of study, work, and residence that is free from abuse, intimidation, and harassment, and where all are treated with respect and courtesy...

CMU offers a Campus Safety Assistants Program, designed to provide safe pedestrian travel around campus for all students, faculty, and staff. The service covers all of the main campus and extends up to two blocks off campus. In addition, emergency telephones are strategically placed around campus, and when activated, the phones provide a direct connection via a 911 line to the regional communications center.
