Congratulations, after a detailed review by the Accreditation Committee, the Executive Committee of the American Association of Professional Landman (“AAPL”) has approved the Colorado Mesa University, Department of Business, Landman Energy Management (the “Program”) for accreditation in accordance with the current guidelines of the AAPL Accreditation Committee. This determination is based upon the submitted application and the completed on-site evaluation performed by the Accreditation Committee. This accreditation entitles the Program to the full benefits of accreditation with an effective date of September 1, 2017 and is valid for two years. Prior to the expiration date the Program will need to contact the AAPL to ensure that a review is completed and any material changes of the Program are communicated. It is the responsibility of the Program to ensure this process progresses and a lapse of accreditation does not occur. The Program is subject to any changes to the AAPL Accreditation Committee Policy and application.

AAPL’s approval of the Program provides enrolled students and graduates of the Program many benefits including additional experiential credit when applying for AAPL certifications upon graduation, student memberships, complimentary access to certain AAPL education events, eligibility to apply for AAPL scholarships through the Landman Scholarship Trust and eligibility to apply for AAPL Outstanding Graduate. The Director of the Program, shall be required to attend the annual meeting of the AAPL Landman Scholarship Trust (“LST”) in Fort Worth, Texas held each January and provide a Program report to the Accreditation Committee and the LST Trustees detailing the Program’s demographics, accomplishments, needs, curriculum changes, student association activities and further details about the Program as may be requested by AAPL.
