At its October 19, 2022 Full Board meeting the State Board of Nursing voted to accept the NCLEX-RN action plan for Colorado Mesa University, Montrose Campus AAS program, and continue the waiver of one year requirement after graduation for the first class for Colorado Mesa University, Montrose Campus AAS program to receive Phase IV Full approval and extend the Interim Approval an additional year as NCLEX-RN pass rates for first time test takers are showing improvement. Follow-up for Colorado Mesa University, Montrose Campus associate degree nursing education program progress toward achieving 75% pass-rate average for first time test takers will be one year of October 25, 2023.
