

Using a Panopto Quiz as a Graded Activity in D2L

Use this guide to learn how to **add quizzes** of multiple types to your Panopto recordings to increase engagement with your videos. These quizzes are great for formative assessment. And, with our updated Panopto integration, instructors can add Panopto quizzes for more summative, graded assessments to the grade book in D2L.

Important reminder: While Panopto gives you a choice for grading the percentage of the video viewed or quiz results, please choose **Grade on quiz results**. The % option does not work with D2L.

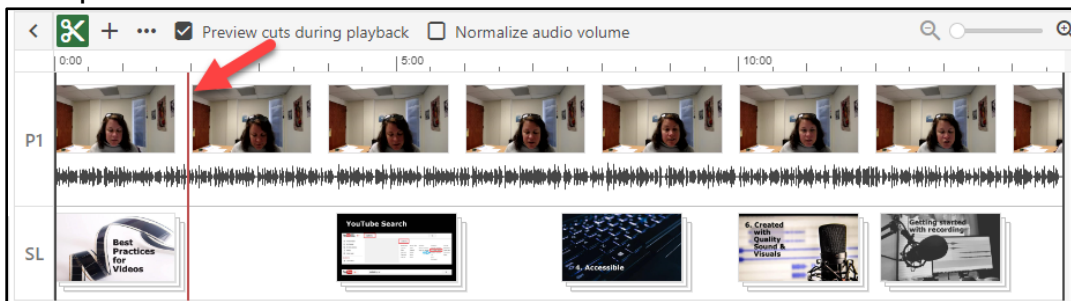
Add a Quiz to a Panopto Video

1. Navigate to the video where you wish to add the quiz.
2. Click on the video and click the **Edit** (pencil) icon.

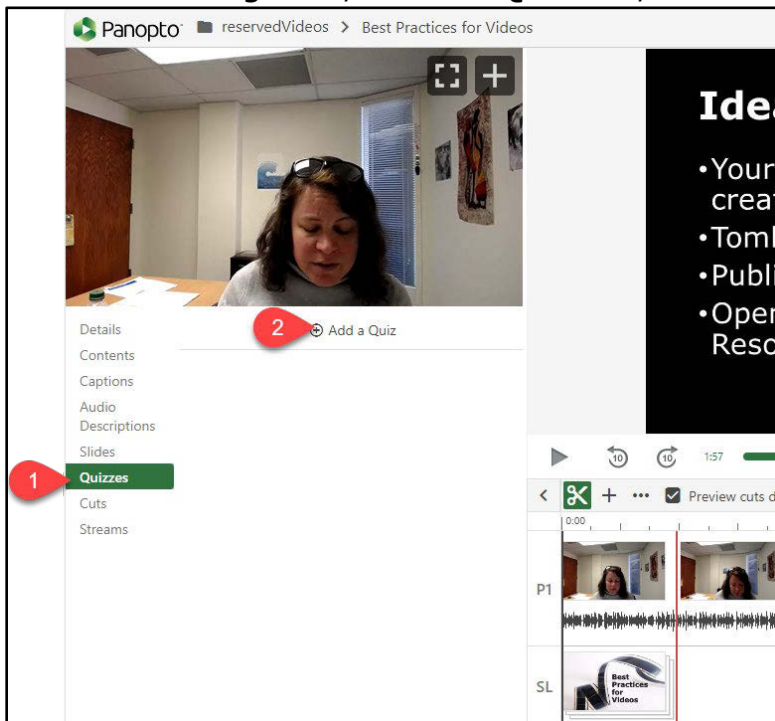


Note: Depending on the length of the video, it may take a few moments for the video to be ready for editing.


3. Once the video editor is open, click on the video timeline where you'd like to insert the quiz. You'll notice a red line in the timeline.



4. In the left navigation, click on **Quizzes**, then **Add a Quiz**.




5. In the **Quiz** interface, add your questions and answers. You have the option to add a Correct answer explanation as well.


Note: The default question type is Multiple Choice, but if you click the drop-down menu, you may select **True/False**, **Multiple Choice**, **Multiple Select**, or **Fill in the Blank**.

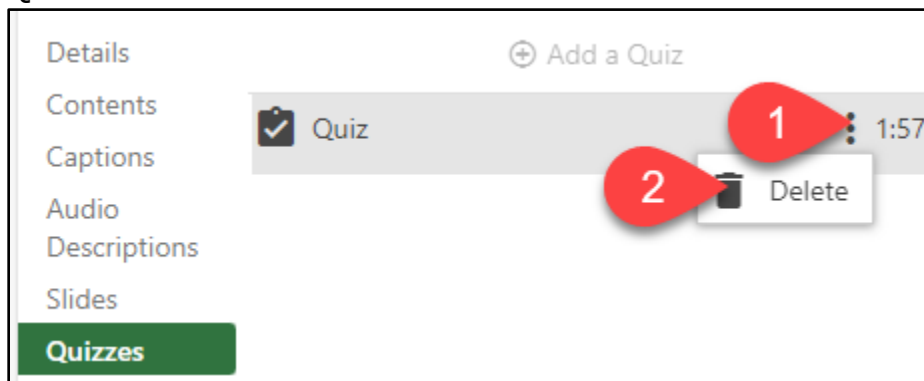
6. Add additional questions to your quiz with the **Add a Question** button or click **Done**.

7. Select your quiz options. All options are checked by default, but you may uncheck those you do not want:
- Allow viewers to retake this quiz,**
 - Show grade after taking this quiz,**
 - Allow review of correct answers and explanations,**
 - Block advancing in the video until answering this quiz.**

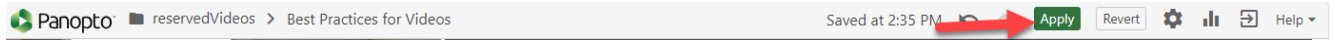


Note: If you have multiple questions, you may adjust the order on this screen as well, by clicking on the **up and down arrows**. You may delete a question by clicking the **X** button. Use the **Back** button if you need to edit questions. For more details on question types, please refer to [Panopto's How to Add a Quiz to a Video guide](#).

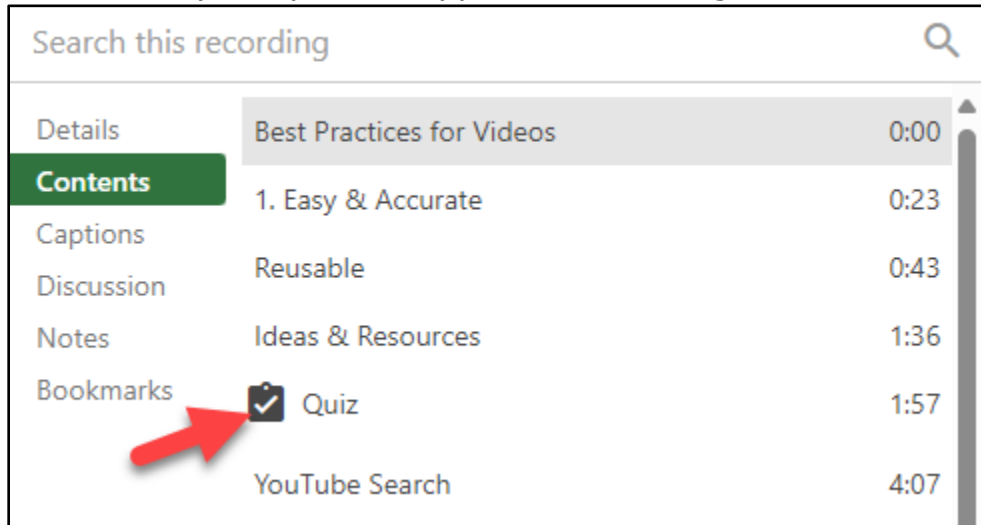
8. When you are finished with your selections, click **Finish**.
9. If you wish to add additional quiz questions at other points in your video, follow steps 3-8.
10. If you need to delete a quiz from your video, click the **3-dot** icon by the Quiz and click **Delete**.



11. Once you've added all quizzes you want to the video, click **Apply**.



12. Now, your quiz will appear in the navigation.



Edit a Quiz

If you need to edit a quiz item, open the video editor > Quizzes > select the quiz you wish to edit. Then follow the same steps you used to create the quiz.

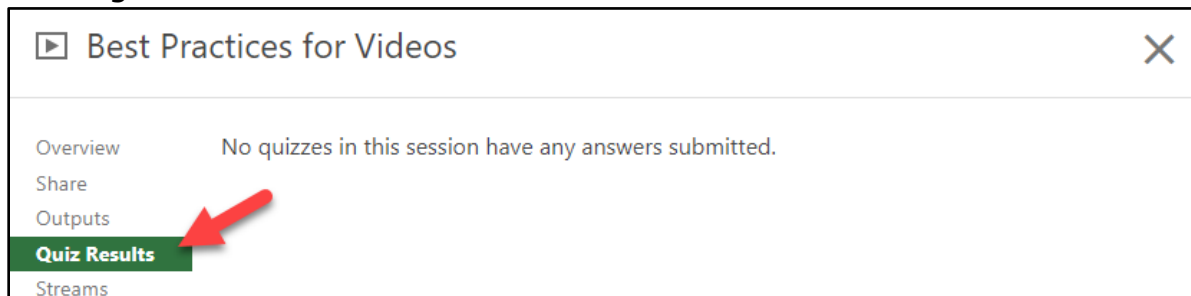
Note: If you attempt to edit a quiz that someone has already completed, you will receive a warning message that they may need to retake the quiz. Select the **Continue** button to proceed with editing.

View Quiz Results

1. Navigate to your video with the quiz.
2. Click the **Settings** (gear) icon.



3. In the left navigation, click **Quiz Results**. (If no one has completed your quiz, you'll receive a **No quizzes in this session have any answers submitted** message.)

Insert a Panopto Video Quiz

1. Navigate to the module where you wish to add your Panopto video quiz.
2. In the Existing Activities drop-down menu, select Panopto deep-link quiz.





3. In **Add Activity**, select **Grade on quiz results**. (The Grade on % viewed option does not work.) Then, click **Continue**.




4. Click **Insert**.



Note: If you embed a video with multiple quizzes, they will be rolled up into one score and tracked as one assignment instead of as individual quizzes in the video.

5. The video quiz will now appear in your module as the title of your video. You may rename it if you wish to indicate a quiz is associated with it. For example, Video Quiz – Best Practices for Videos.



Syncing a Video Quiz to the Gradebook

1. Click on the video quiz link. While the video opens in a new tab, go back to your original tab to access **Activity Details**.
2. In **Activity Details** > **Assessment**, click on **Add a grade item**.







4. In **New Grade Item**, add the **Name** and **maximum point value**. You may complete any other fields as needed, such as Category, as needed. Click **Create**.




