



Respondus Lockdown Browser

LockDown Browser® is a custom browser that locks down the testing environment within a learning management system.

To use the Lockdown Browser (LDB) you will have to have your students [download and install the browser](#) to their personal systems unless they are using a campus computer which is already equipped. Faculty do not need to download the browser to utilize these features. You can download the browser (with IT permission) to test the process for your students.


4. Select the "Require Respondus Lockdown Browser for this exam " option




5. Select "Save + Close" to exit the dashboard.



USING LOCKDOWN BROWSER FOR ONLINE EXAMS

This course requires the use of LockDown Browser for online exams. Watch this [short video](#) to get a basic understanding of LockDown Browser and the optional webcam feature (which may be required for some exams).

To take an online test, click the quiz link within D2L. at the bottom of the quiz page there will be a reminder to either download the LDB or start the LDB. Once you start the LDB, it will limit all access to communication and other browsers on the device.

Finally, when taking an online exam, follow these guidelines:

- Select a location where you won't be interrupted
- Before starting the test, know how much time is available for it, and that you've allotted sufficient time to complete it
- Turn off all mobile devices, phones, etc. and don't have them within reach
- Clear your area of all external materials — books, papers, other computers, or devices
- Remain at your desk or workstation for the duration of the test
- LockDown Browser will prevent you from accessing other websites or applications; you will be unable to exit the test until all questions are completed and submitted
