# Scholarship Consideration

---

- CU-CMU students should complete the CU-Boulder Engineering Merit Scholarship Application for CU-CMU Partner Students for your junior year to be considered for scholarships (if you were admitted to the program by 4/6/16, you should have received an email with the application link).
- Please apply if your CMU GPA is  $\geq 3.000$

# 2016-2017 Academic Year Award Levels - Juniors

- Junior Year, 2016-2017
  - Students who completed the scholarship application may receive scholarships ranging from \$500-\$1,750 in their junior year depending on their **CMU** cumulative GPA.
    - \$1,750 per year if CMU GPA is 4.000
    - \$1,500 per year if CMU GPA is 3.900 – 3.999
    - \$1,250 per year if CMU GPA is 3.800 – 3.899
    - \$1,000 per year if CMU GPA is 3.600 – 3.799
    - Possible scholarships for 3.000 – 3.599 depending on availability of funds and application.

# What if I didn't apply?

- Students who were admitted to the CU/CMU Mechanical Engineering program after April 6, 2016 should contact Gretchen Lee, Scholarship Coordinator, and request an application link.
- You must apply to be considered for larger scholarships.

# 2016-2017 Academic Year Awarding- Seniors

- Senior Year, 2016-2017

- Students who apply by March 1 of their junior year may be awarded a scholarship in the senior year in a manner consistent with CU-Boulder engineering students. Please use the CU-Boulder Merit Scholarship application.

  - Based on:
    - Funding availability
    - Student GPAs

# Heads Up!

- **How will I know if I received a scholarship?** Engineering will send you an email award letter via your Colorado.EDU email account. Watch this email for other scholarship opportunities as well.
- **When will my scholarship credit to my bill?** Scholarship funds are not released until 10 days prior to the start of the academic term and are split between fall and spring semesters.
- **My scholarship did not credit to my account?** Sometimes the Boulder system does not see that you are jointly enrolled full-time and will not release the funds.
