Scholarship Consideration

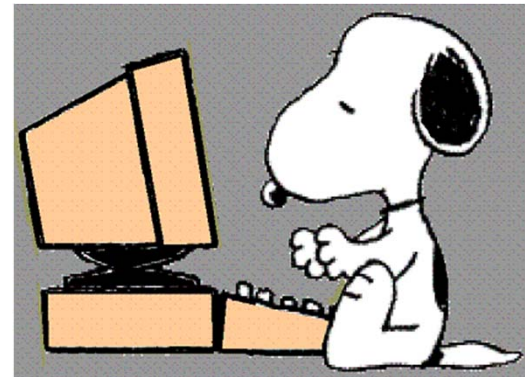
- CU-CMU students should complete the CU Boulder Engineering Merit Scholarship Application for CU-CMU Partner Students for your junior year to be considered for scholarships. Email Gretchen or Tim Brower for the link to the application.
- Please apply if your CMU GPA is ≥ 3.000

2018-2019 Academic Year Award Levels - Juniors

- Junior Year, 2018-2019
 - Students who completed the scholarship application may receive scholarships ranging from \$500-\$1,750 in their junior year depending on their **CMU** cumulative GPA.
 - \$2,000 per year if CMU GPA is 4.000
 - \$1,750 per year if CMU GPA is 3.900 – 3.999
 - \$1,500 per year if CMU GPA is 3.800 – 3.899
 - \$1,250 per year if CMU GPA is 3.700 – 3.799
 - \$1,000 per year if CMU GPA is 3.600 – 3.699
 - \$ 500 per year if CMU GPA is 3.000 – 3.599

What if I didn't apply?

- You must apply to be considered for scholarships and possible internships attached to the scholarships.



2019-2020 Academic Year Awarding- Seniors

- Senior Year, 2019-2020
 - Students who apply by March 1st of their junior year may be awarded a scholarship in the senior year in a manner consistent with CU Boulder engineering students. Please use the [CU Boulder Merit Scholarship application](#).

Review and Revision of Scholarship Awarding Criteria

 - Based on:
 - Funding availability
 - Student GPAs



FAQ's

- **How will I know if I received a scholarship?** The college will send you an email award letter via your Colorado.EDU email account. Always watch this email for listings of scholarship opportunities that we learn about.
- **When will my scholarship credit to my bill?** Scholarship funds are not released until 10 days prior to the start of the academic term and are split between fall and spring semesters.
- **My scholarship did not credit to my account?** Sometimes the Boulder system does not see that you are jointly enrolled and will not release your funds. If you receive a message in your student portal about your enrollment or funds on hold, please contact the Office of Financial Aid at scholarships@Colorado.edu or Gretchen Lee at Gretchen.Lee@Colorado.edu
