# Page 23 Curriculum Manual Essential Learning Requirements and Degree Categories

a. Essential Learning Requirement for Associate of Applied Science Programs. The Essential Learning requirements for the Associate of Applied Science must include a minimum of fifteen (15) semester credit hours to include 3 hours of written communication and 3 hours of written or oral communication, a minimum of three hours of mathematics, and a minimum of six hours of Social Sciences, Natural Science, Fine Arts, or Humanities, or a combination of 3 hours from Social Sciences, Natural Science, Fine Arts, or Humanities as determined by the program. In addition to the Essential Learning requirements, other lower division requirements are to include KINE 100 Health and Wellness and one hour of Kinesiology activity (KINA). Additional lower division requirements may apply to some degrees, e.g. Prerequisites. 2. Degree Categories for Bachelor Prog
