ANNOUNCEMENTS AND INFORMATION ITEMS:

August 22, 2013

New members to the committee introduced themselves: Scott Kessler, Mechanical Engineering, Physical and Environmental Sciences; Jeremy Hawkins, Athletic Training Program Director, Kinesiology; Jill Van Brussel, Costume Designer, Theatre; and Jack Bryan, Chief of Staff, Associated Student Government.

Jessie Barnett, Special Projects Coordinator—Academic Affairs, is the new recording secretary.

Per the "fast track" policy, in May the executive members acknowledged on behalf of the committee the new technical certificate programs WCCC developed for the TAACCT grant: Basic Welder, CAD/CAM, Certified Network Technician, Computer Technician, Control Systems Technician, and Electronics Technician

Any changes to the curriculum change forms should be made at the last meeting of the year to take effect for the following academic year.

It was noted that Faculty Senate has expressed concerns with the number of committee members whose term will be expiring during the same year and may take action to address this.

Motion: to recommend to Faculty Senate that the Director of Financial Aid be added as an ex officio member to the Undergraduate Curriculum Committee (Atkinson/Chapin); motion carried.

The Chair explained that subgroups help review proposals prior to each month's meeting. Each subgroup has a point person who compiles comments from the subgroup members.

It was noted that the General Education working group is working on a potential proposal for Faculty Senate to add another Standing Committee to review the general education courses.

New programs or extensively modified programs must be reviewed by the Director of Financial Aid in order to ensure that they meet the guidelines for students to receive federal financial aid. The Committee should only consider/approve programs that meet the guidelines.

September 26, 2013

To help eliminate the need for corrections, committee members must now submit curriculum proposal forms on behalf of their department.

October 24, 2013

The committee approved the 2012-13 Annual Report.

There is a new email address to use for curriculum proposals, including corrections: <u>UCC_chair@coloradomesa.edu</u>. The UCC Chair and Vice Chair, the Assistant VPAA and the Recording Secretary from Academic Affairs will have access.

Chair Tucci, Vice Chair Atkinson and Don Carpenter plan to work to update the Policies and Procedures Manual to include:

- new submittal procedures for proposal, including new email address and that proposals must come from the department's committee representative;
- updated instructions on completing curriculum proposal forms, including clarification on when to use the Intra-Departmental Change Memo; and
- new sub-group review procedures.

As the committee often approves proposals with noted corrections, the list of corrections received or pending from previous meetings will be included under "Old Business" on each agenda. The corrected forms will not be sent out for committee review as the committee Chair will verify that the needed changes have been made. Proposals approved pending corrections need follow-up by the department and the committee representative but departments do not need to send a faculty member to discuss items noted under "Old Business."

November 14, 2013

There was discussion about whether or not the Center for Teacher Education has oversight over the Early Childhood programs at WCCC. Committee members presented conflicting opinions about whether the Director of Teacher Education needs to sign the proposals related to Early Childhood associate degrees. The Policy and Procedures Manual may need updated to clarify this issue.

There was an issue with the approval of the course addition of GEOL 108 because the wrong name was noted in the agenda materials and the minutes from the 9/26/13 meeting. Motion: to note that there was an error in the minutes of 9/26/13. GEOL 108 Water Essentials should have been GEOL 108 Water, People and Environment (Carpenter/Hawkins; motion carried.

In order to be accepted, proposals must be sent to UCC_Chair@coloradomesa.edu by the committee members representing each department. After proposals are reviewed by the Chair, they will be placed on the R drive and assigned to be reviewed by a sub-group. Sub-group members will review and send needed corrections to their group's point person. The point person will send the needed corrections back to the same email address. The Chair will forward the needed corrections to the committee representative and the department head. The revised proposals reflecting the needed corrections must be returned to the same email address by the committee member representing the department.

December 5, 2013

Carpenter reported the Graduate Curriculum Committee (GCC) is considering changes to the Combined Curriculum Policy and Procedures Manual. The proposed changes involve incorporating instructions for completing forms into the Manual, rather than having the instructions in a separate document. The instructions will be included in a newly created "Section 6." The GCC also discussed other possible changes to the policies and procedures, to include:

- ensure that the curriculum change forms match the current procedures
- remove the procedures from the forms and add hyperlinks to the Manual.
- change the forms to web-based forms with built-in guidelines.

The UCC should expect to see a proposal to streamline the forms immediately, as well as a more comprehensive change proposal to modernize and update the forms in the coming years.

The Chair noted that all corrections needed from this year's previous meetings have now been received. Atkinson noted the benefit of including in the written record whether or not the needed corrections to the pending approved proposals have been completed.

January 23, 2014

The Chair announced that the current ASG representative, student Jack Bryan, has a time conflict and is looking for replacement to serve on this committee in an ex-officio capacity.

The committee reviewed the proposed policy addressing the sub-group structure and review process. It was noted that the 2nd sentence of item B. should be corrected to read "placed" instead of "place."

Motion: to accept the proposed guidelines for the Sub-group Structure and Responsibilities with the noted correction in item B. (Chapin/Hawkins); motion carried.

February 27, 2014

The committee welcomed the new ASG representative, Chelsea Chiovitti.

Gary Looft presented the Construction Technology-Craft programs and course de-activations. The programs have experienced a decline in students in the past few years, reflecting the downturn in the industry. It is hoped that the demand will return as the industry recovers, at which point the department intends to re-activate the courses and programs. Enrollment has been stopped, so a teach-out plan isn't necessary.

The program modification proposal for the BS, Mechanical Engineering Technology includes a request that this program, now called Applied Mechanical Engineering be added to the list of Professional/Technical/Other programs in the Policy and Procedure Manual permitted to require over 120 credit hours. This was overlooked when the program was first approved.

Motion: to grant the Professional/Technical/Other status to the BS, Mechanical Engineering Technology (Applied Mechanical Engineering) program and include it in the list in the Policy and Procedures Manual (Carpenter/Carsten); motion carried.

Due to the applied nature of some of the requirements of the BA, Criminal Justice, Law Enforcement concentration, the department, in consultation with VPAA Futhey, has concluded that the program is more appropriate offered as a BAS degree. As a BAS is defined as a completer program for the AAS, the wording on the proposed BAS program sheet needs revised so that a student must at least be enrolled in the AAS in Criminal Justice, which contains the POST Academy Certificate and other courses including general education requirements.

Carpenter will work with department faculty to update the wording on the program sheet so that it can be approved within the current definition of a BAS.

March 20, 2014

The committee welcomed the new ASG representative, Ronin Bennett-Vonderostensacken.

Holly Teal provided a brief demonstration of the Degree Works software to be implemented for fall 2014. There was discussion.

April 17, 2014

Chair Tucci thanked the committee for their hard work.

Elections for the 2014-15 academic year were held.

Chair Tucci opened the floor for nominations for UCC Vice-Chair for AY 14-15. Motion: to nominate Jeremy Hawkins for Vice-Chair (Atkinson/Carpenter); motion carried. Motion: to cease nominations for Vice-Chair (Carpenter/Kessler); motion carried. The committee voted to confirm Jeremy Hawkins as Vice-Chair for next year.

Chair Tucci announced that he will not be continuing as department representative for Languages, Literature, and Mass Communication. Motion: to unanimously thank Chair Tucci for his service to the committee (Carpenter/Hawkins); motion carried.

Chair Tucci opened the floor for nominations for UCC Chair for AY 14-15. There was discussion. Some members recommended that a tenured faculty member would be the best choice for the position of Chair.

There were no nominations for the position of Chair. Newly elected 14-15 Vice-Chair Hawkins will convene the first meeting of the year in August and hold elections for the Chair at that time.

The draft of the UCC section of Combined Curriculum Annual Report was briefly discussed. Members were reminded that they are responsible for ensuring accuracy of the annual report on behalf of their respective departments. To allow more time for members to review the report for accuracy of their department's proposals, the UCC section will be approved via email in the coming weeks.

It was clarified that the WCCC section has not yet been made available to the UCC for review. After the WCCC committee finalizes that section, it will be sent to the UCC for approval.

Kurt Haas addressed the committee to explain that Faculty Senate has convened a new committee. The "Essential Learning" committee will be a subcommittee of the UCC. The new committee will be charged with reviewing existing general education (essential learning) curriculum and approving new "Milestone" courses. The composition of the committee included representatives from each Senate group, as well as ex officio members from the Library, Academic Affairs, and the UCC. There was discussion. Motion: the UCC will resolve to include an extra deadline in next year's calendar for submission of proposals for current Applied Studies to be added to the new Essential Learning categories (Carpenter/Carsten); motion carried.

The proposed Essential Learning Subcommittee policy was discussed. Two typographical errors were identified. In addition, the first sentence of item 1.3.a should be changed to: "The Essential Learning Subcommittee will meet to determine whether the course aligns properly with the required number of Essential Learning Program learning outcomes and will vote to approve or deny the proposal." **Motion: to accept the Essential Learning Subcommittee Policy** (Carpenter/Hawkins); motion carried.
