AAS Nursing Program Application – Eligibility Criteria

- 1. Applicants are required to submit their Kaplan Pre-Nursing exam scores as part of their application. They can take the Kaplan once per application period.
- 2. All pre-requisite courses must be at least in-progress by the semester of application, and the applicant must receive a final grade of C or better.
- 3. The GPA of the required AAS Nursing pre-requisite courses must be at least 3.0.
- 4. Those applicants chosen for an interview are the top candidates among those who have applied for that application period and have scored the highest in #1, #2 and #3 above.
- 5. Those chosen for the cohort will have the top scores in the interview, in addition to the GPA and Kaplan requirements.
- 6. Incomplete applications are not considered; all application materials must be submitted by the posted deadline, or the application will be incomplete and not considered for that year's cohort.

The criteria above and the <u>AAS Application Checklist</u> are intended to help applicants plan their application and guide them through the application process.
