Application Deadlines and Submission Instructions:

- Fall Semester tBSN Program Only:
 - o August 15th by 5pm (MST)
 - Please submit this application via your CMU email address with the subject line:
 - "tBSN Application".
- Spring Semester tBSN, AASN, and/or PN Programs:
 - January 15th by 5pm (MST)
 - Please submit this application via your CMU email address with the subject line indicating your intent:
 - "tBSN Application"
 - "tBSN and AASN Application"
 - "tBSN and PN Application"
 - "tBSN, AASN, and PN Application"

This check-off form is intended to help you meet the Undergraduate Nursing Application requirements. <u>DO NOT</u> submit this form, as it is a tool to help guide you through the process.

PLEASE NOTE: Your application file will **NOT** be evaluated if it is not submitted by the deadlines listed above. You are encouraged to submit your application and supporting documents early.

Application to Colorado Mesa University:

- 1. If you are not currently enrolled or accepted as a bachelor-seeking student (if applying to the tBSN program); associate-seeking (if applying to the AASN program); or certificate-seeking (if applying to the PN program) at Colorado Mesa University (CMU), you need to apply as soon as possible.
 - a. To check your status, log into MavZone. Your major is listed under your photo/name on the main landing page.
 - i. Your major does not need to be listed as a pre-BSN; pre-AASN or pre-PN to apply to these programs.
 - ii. However, you must be accepted to CMU at the appropriate level for the program you are applying for.
 - 1. Bachelor-seeking for the tBSN, AASN, and PN programs (any bachelor's major is acceptable).
 - 2. Associate-seeking for AASN and PN programs (any associate major is acceptable).
 - 3. Certificate-seeking for PN program (any certificate major is acceptable).
 - iii. If your current major is not at the level for the program you are applying for, you must contact IRIS to complete the appropriate paperwork to update your major-seeking level.

b. Important: Submit all official transcripts from previous schools to the Registrar's Office as early as possible. Transcript evaluations can take several weeks to complete.

General Application Directions:

- 1. Open the application using Acrobat Adobe to ensure proper formatting.
 - a. Only .pdf files will be accepted.
 - b. Attach the file directly to your email do not send a link.
 - c. Do not submit files in .jpeg, .tiff, or other formats.
- 2. Complete and electronically sign the application, then save it to your computer.
 - a. If you can't e-sign, print the form, sign it manually, then scan and save it as a .pdf.
- 3. Submit the completed application as a .pdf attachment from your CMU email to healthscience@coloradomesa.edu.
 - a. Applications received <u>after 5pm (MST)</u> on the deadline WILL NOT be considered.
 - b. Submit early to avoid technical or other issues.
 - c. Only include documents that are specifically requested, others will not be reviewed.
- 4. If accepted, additional documentation will be required. Refer to the BSN, AASN, and/or PN Handbook for full details.
 - a. Final acceptance requires completion of all prerequisites, essential learning, a background check, and drug screen.
 - b. Be prepared to provide documentation for the following:
 - i. Immunization/Vaccinations: MMR, Varicella, Hep B, COVID-19, Influenza, Tdap, TB Skin Test. You are encouraged to gain official proof of immunizations/vaccinations that you have completed.
 - ii. Do not submit these items now. Instructions for submitting them will be included in your acceptance letter.
 - iii. Start gathering official proof of your immunizations to avoid delays later.

Timeline of the Application Process

(General timeline – actual dates may vary slightly)

Application Deadline: all materials **MUST** be received no later than 5pm (MST) on the listed deadline. **Late applications will NOT be accepted or processed.**

~Week 1-2 Post Application Deadline:

Applicants will receive a personal confirmation email (not the automatic reply email). If you haven't received this by the 10^{th} business day, contact us at: healthscience@coloradomesa.edu.

~Week 2-4 Post Application Deadline:

Admission Committee reviews all completed applications, per program of application.

~Week 4-6 Post Application Deadline:

Decision letters sent to all applicants (decline or invite to interview), per program of application.

~Week 6-9 Post Application Deadline:

Interviews conducted for selected applicants, per program of application.

~Week 9-10 Post Application Deadline:

Final letters sent to all interviewees (decline or acceptance), per program of application.
