Definition of Interactive and On-line Enrollments:

Interactive televised course is a course that is delivered live using technology that allows the student to see the instructor and discuss issues the televised sessions (i.e., the student at the remote site can immediately respond to a question posed by the instructor at the host site during the class). To be eligible for FTE funding, 51% of the scheduled course meetings must be interactive.

Internet courses is a course in which the student actively participates in a course using computer software to view demonstrations, hear lectures, participate in threaded conversations, and respond to assignments on the web. To qualify for FTE funding, all class meetings must be delivered on the web, excluding the midterm and the final examination.

All other distance education courses are reported in the right column -- Not claimed for state support.
