Certified Professional Landman – Biography

Dennis began his career as a landman in Denver CO in 1978 with Frontier Land and Exploration, an oil and gas lease brokerage firm, after graduating from Colorado State University with a B.A. in political science and then attending the University of Idaho College of Law. After one year with Frontier, Dennis opted to become an independent contractor and provided federal, state and fee title and leasing services, sale representation, drill site curative, mineral and royalty appraisals, and supervision of field landmen throughout the Rockies, California and Michigan. In 1987, after the oil and gas industry bust in the mid 1980's, Dennis donned a coat and tie and worked as a personal trust administrator in Grand Junction CO and then in Cheyenne WY for four years, prior to a two-year stint as a real estate broker in Colorado and Wyoming. Dennis returned to contract land work in 1993 and then served as a staff landman with Hanson & Strahn, Inc., an oil and gas land services company based in Cheyenne WY. In 2002 Dennis accepted an employment offer from Devon Energy Corporation as a Land Advisor in Devon's Gillette WY office, where he negotiated and acquired surface agreements and settled surface damage claims for coal bed methane drilling and production. Dennis retired from Devon in 2010.
