The CMU Jazz Workshop is a day camp of three and a half days of intensive jazz studies centered on small group performance and jazz improvisation. Students will receive instruction from outstanding CMU and Guest Faculty in Jazz Theory and Improvisation, Jazz History, and Jazz Combo performance. The workshop is open to all students graduating from grades 8-12 this spring.

Directions to Camp: The Colorado Mesa University Jazz Workshop is held in the Moss Performing Arts Center on the southeast part of campus. (on 12th street near the corner of 12th and North). Cars may pay to park in pay lots or parking garage. Free parking is also available on nearby streets across 12th Street.

Check –In and Audition: 1:00-1:30 p.m. on Tuesday, May 31 near Love Recital Hall in the Moss Performing Arts Center. Auditions begin at 1:00 p.m. Quietly wait outside your audition room until there is an opening. You may put your cases in Love Recital Hall and warm up in Love Recital Hall or a practice room.

Audition Material: Students should bring to the audition a jazz etude or an excerpt from their school jazz band literature that is representative of their playing level. Improvisation is optional; you may bring your own recorded accompaniment or play along to a blues accompaniment provided.

What to Bring: All students should bring a notebook and pencil. Percussionists should bring sticks, brushes, and mallets for vibraphone. Bass and guitar players need to bring a patch cord in good condition (amps will be provided for bass and guitar players). Sax players need to bring extra reeds. Brass players need to have valve or slide oil and may wish to bring various mutes.

T-shirt: Each participant will receive a Camp T-shirt, which will be worn for the final concert.

Meals: Lunch will be served Wednesday – Friday in the University Center and is included in the cost of registration.
