Concurrent, Dual Enrollment, or Transfer Credits

High school transcripts cannot be used to evaluate concurrent or dual enrollment classes; it must be a college transcript from the institution granting college credit.

AP Exams

Find the title of your AP Exam and score, then find the corresponding class(es) in the CMU Course Equivalent column to see how the class will transfer to CMU. For example, if you took the AP English Literature and Composition exam and scored a 4, you would receive credit for ENGL 150 and ENGL 112 (for a total of 6 credit hours). You must request an official copy of your AP score report be sent to CMU to receive credit!
