Enrollment Steps Checklist:

- Locate the Golden Scholars Application
 - ☐ Complete the Application, located at <http://www.coloradomesa.edu/goldenscholars>
 - ☐ Return it to the Registrar's Office at any time prior to registration. Note it takes up to 3 business days to process the application and there is no application fee.
 - You will receive a letter confirming your application has been processed which will include your student ID number, username, and password for accessing the student MAVzone

- Look up course(s)
 - ☐ You can access the course listing through www.coloradomesa.edu/register or through your [MAVzone](#) by using your user name and password to login to view how many seats are available in courses.
- Enroll in your course(s):
 - ☐ You may register for course(s) starting no earlier than the week before each semester's course(s) begin
 - You may enroll in course(s) at the Registrar's Office, IRIS Office or through [MAVzone](#).
 - ☐ If the course is closed or you encounter other registration restrictions, you will need to submit a [Course Override](#) form. If the instructor will allow you to add the course, they will approve your e form and enter an override that will allow you to be enrolled into the course(s) in MavZone or in person at the Registrars Office or IRIS Office.
 - ☐ To add during the Late Add Period, you will need to submit a [Late Add](#) form. If the instructor approves the form will be routed to the Registrars Office and you will be added.
- Get your MAVcard
 - Once enrolled in the course(s), bring your student ID number and a copy of your schedule to the MAVcard office located in the University Center.
 - Let them know you are part of the Golden Scholars Program. There is no fee for your first ID card. The MAVcard is your library card and your pass for other student discounts.
- Pay your bill.
 - Payment is due to the Student Accounts Office by the first day of class. They can be paid online  [MAVzone](#) or contacting [IRIS](#).
 - Tuition and fees are not assessed until you are officially enrolled in the course(s).
 - The tuition rate is \$25 per credit hour for in classroom courses and \$100 for online courses plus any regular course fees for the no grade, audit status. Most lecture courses do not have an additional course fee. Typical courses with additional fees are art, science labs, technology-based courses, online/distance courses, and a handful of specialized Extended Studies courses. Course fees are listed in the "Fees" column of the course schedule.
