

Selecting a Section Attribute

All sections in Spring 2021 must select one of the Section Attributes that indicate the section's delivery method. Section Attributes are visible to students in Self-Service Banner to provide them with a clearer idea of the delivery method being used. Additionally, Section Attributes will be used by the Registrar's Office to help determine proper room placement.

1. On Edit Section screen, click the Edit (Pencil) icon next to the Section Attributes.

Section Attributes should properly align with the Delivery Field, as listed in the table below. (*Note: Experiential may be selected in the Delivery Field if it is an Internship, Clinical, Practicum, etc. If choosing Experiential, please select the most appropriate Section Attribute for that course's particular delivery.)

Section Attribute	Description	Delivery Field*
Delivery: Full Class In-Person	Traditional classroom delivery where all students attend class in person every day.	Classroom Based
Delivery: Hybrid (Traditional)	Traditional hybrid delivery where all students attend class in person one or more days per week and additional content is delivered online.	Blended (Hybrid)
Delivery: Online	Asynchronous online course, where all course content is delivered online.	Web Based
Delivery: Online w/Day & Time	Synchronous online course, where all course content is delivered online but there are set days/times for lectures and activities that are delivered via Zoom or other online platform.	Web Based
Delivery: Partial Class w/Web	Course that would typically be delivered via in-person or hybrid format but due to COVID room capacity limits, students are split into smaller groups and do not all attend in person at the same time.	Classroom Based or Blended (Hybrid)

Note:

Some courses may have other Section Attributes that are preassigned and cannot be removed. This includes Essential Learning Courses, approved GT-Pathways Courses, Differential Tuition, etc. In these instances, you can still add the additional Delivery Attribute following the instructions above.
