### BED AND BATH

- Mattress pad and pillow(s)
- Towels and washcloths
- Shower shoes and robe
- Shampoo/Conditioner
- Toothbrush/Toothpaste
- Trash can for bathroom (non-traditional halls and apartments)
- Toilet paper (non-traditional halls and apartments)

### ELECTRONICS

- Power strip with surge protector
- Extension cords
- Gaming console
- Computer/tablet; printer
- TV (may not be mounted on wall)
- Headphones
- Batteries
- CAT 6 ethernet cable

### APPLIANCES

- Iron with auto shut off
- Alarm clock
- Microwave (under 900 watts)\*
- Refrigerator (up to 5 cubic ft.)\*
- Single-serve coffee makers (example: Keurig)
- Small set of dishes, pots, utensils

### LAUNDRY ITEMS

- Laundry bag/basket
- Hangers
- Detergent - High Efficiency (HE) soap only, No pods or laundry beads
- Dryer sheets
- Stain remover
- Clothes drying rack

### CLEANING ITEMS

- Broom/Swiffer Wet Mop
- Bathroom (non-traditional halls and apartments)
- Kitchen cleaning supplies (apartments only)

- Binders, papers, pen/pencils, highlighters
- Planner

### MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

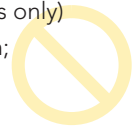
- Coffee mug

## DON'T BRING IT!

To reduce health and safety risks, as well as to help ensure the best possible educational environment for all students, the following items are prohibited from all the Residence Halls:

- Alcohol beverages
- Marijuana or related paraphernalia
