

Every community has certain guidelines, regulations and traditions - which all members of the community are expected to abide by and uphold. A university community, even more than others, depends upon the integrity, self-discipline, and mature judgment of each of its members. **By accepting admission to Colorado Mesa University, each student agrees to live by the standards of this community**, found in the University Catalog, the Student and Academic Policy Guide, and within the Residence Life Community Guidelines. It is your responsibility as a student to read and know the policies of Colorado Mesa University.

<p>Explanation of Possible Sanctions</p> <p>Warning: A Letter of Warning is official notification that the student has violated the University Student Code of Conduct, and repeat or other violations may result in more serious sanctions.</p> <p>Fines: Fines are monetary penalties placed directly on a student's account. These monies go directly to the University and are used to fund the institution's programming/prevention efforts.</p> <p>Work Hours: Assignment of work hours in service to the community (University). Failure to complete hours by the deadline may result in a fine.</p> <p>Prime for Life: A group class held with other CMU students, facilitated by counselor, Bob Lang. Failure to complete the course (4-8 full sessions) by the deadline may result in a fine.</p> <p>Life Skills Class: Making better life choices</p> <p>Substance Use Assessment: A one on one addictions assessment plan with a CMU counselor. Failure to complete the prescribed treatment plan by the deadline may result in a \$150 fine and the CMU student's standing with the institution to be at risk, as the student will be required to meet with the Campus Conduct Coordinator to determine if the student is fit to be a student or other sanctions as assigned.</p> <p>Discretionary Sanction: A unique sanction typically associated with the type of violation and its impact on the community. Examples include writing a paper, creating a bulletin board, attend RHC/RHA, shadowing an RA, or designing a community event.</p> <p>Parental Notification: Letter or phone call to the student's parents/legal guardians. Notification will include information about repeated or serious violations of the Student Code of Conduct.</p> <p>Residence Hall Probation: This is the most serious form of behavior-related sanction imposed short of removal from housing. Even a minor violation of the Student Code of Conduct may result in removal from housing/Termination of Contract.</p> <p>Relocation: Re-assignment from a particular on-campus space to another. The student will forfeit the living space of her/his choice for the academic year and be required to pay the room rate difference.</p> <p>Removal/Termination of Contract: A student's contract for her/his on-campus space is canceled and the student is responsible for all associated costs, charges, and fees for the current semester.</p> <p>Referral to University Conduct Officer/Board: Due to the repetitive or serious nature of the alleged violation (s), the student is referred to the University Conduct Officer / Board for possible suspension or expulsion.</p> <p>Discretionary Sanctions can include but are not limited to</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Create a COVID awareness campaign ▪ Create a virtual program via Teams or Zoom ▪ Creating a cleaning chart ▪ Community service ▪ Cleaning with the custodian staff ▪ Sanitize lounges, computer labs, elevator, kitchens, front/main lobbies ▪ Attend University sanctioned programs ▪ Writing assignments 	<p>Note: These are "typical" sanctions and thus may change based upon the circumstances of the specific incident and a student's prior conduct history.</p>	<p>1st Offense</p>	<p>2nd Offense</p>	<p>3rd Offense</p>	<p>4th Offense</p>
