

## PRAXIS Licensure Exam Registration Steps

- Go to <https://www.ets.org/praxis>.
  - Click on **Login/Register** in the top right corner.
  - Under **PRAXIS**, click **Sign In** or **Create Account**. You will either enter your background information, or if you already have an account, confirm your account and information.
  - In Praxis account, go to **Search and Select Tests** (see Fig. 1)
  - In the **State/Agency Required Tests** section, select the state (Colorado) OR the state agency (CDE) to locate required exam/s.
  - Click the **Search** button.
  - Select the appropriate test (*they are listed alphabetically; see list on reverse side of this form*).
  - You may then choose to **Test from Home** or you may **Select Test Center** (ex: CMU Testing & Prometric Center)
  - Select the date, location, and time that you want to test.
  - Follow the rest of the steps to pay for the test and confirm your registration.
  - Make sure you have your scores sent to Colorado Mesa University—recipient code **4484**.
  - After you receive your score report/s, make sure to download them and save your own copy for your records. You will need a copy of your score/s to submit with your licensure application after graduation.

## What Tests, When and Where to take them, & How to prepare?

To be eligible for student teaching, all teacher candidates must submit passing scores for state-approved content area licensure exams prior to the start of their internship semester. **Students are encouraged to take their Praxis Content Exams at the end of their junior year/summer before their student teaching placement.**
