

**EDUC 499A-J**  
**Teaching Internship and Colloquia**  
**Course Requirements**

The Teaching Internship and Colloquia course is a full-time (40 hrs min/week) supervised teaching experience designed to allow the intern the opportunity to apply standards-based education and theories and philosophies acquired in professional education coursework. An orientation and two required colloquia on pre-scheduled evenings are included during this experience. Interns must complete and meet all requirements and earn a grade of B or better in order to be recommended for licensure.
